




*The IESOL Diploma is issued to learners who have successfully completed the IESOL and ISESOL qualifications at the same level.

The Border and Immigration Agency is an executive agency of the Home Office, responsible for controlling the borders and managing immigration in the UK.

From 2008, individuals from outside the European Union wishing to come to or remain in the UK to are required to provide evidence that they have an acceptable standard of English. Only tests approved by the Home Office will be accepted as part of the visa application process.



Formed in 2004 from two previous associations (the Association of Recognised English Language Services and the British Association of State English Language Teaching), they have around 400 member centres in private schools, educational trusts and charities, further education colleges and universities.
